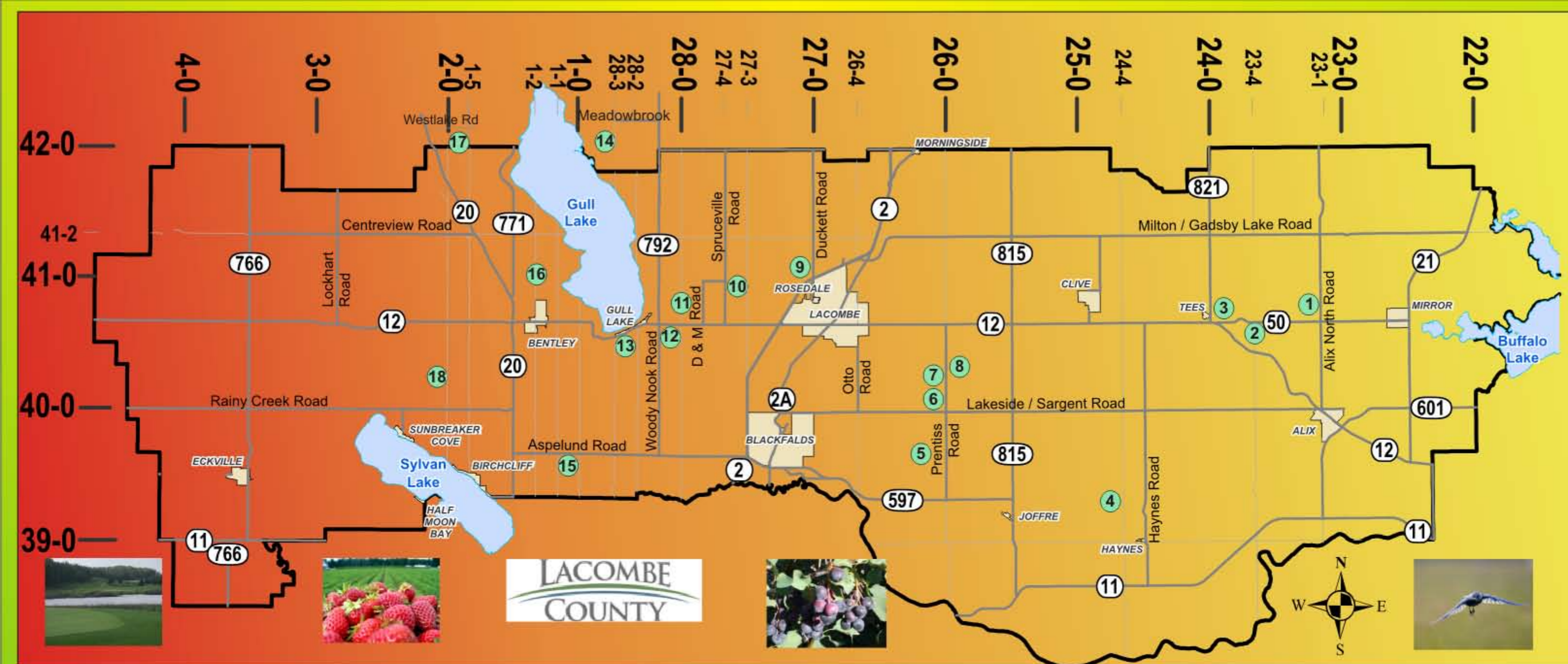

Sunrise Farms (East of Highway 2 [QE II])

- 1. Morris Meadows**
Go N from Alix on RR 23-1 for 8.1 km. By appointment please.
- 2. Celestine Farms**
Go E from Lacombe on Hwy 12 for 30 km, turn onto Hwy 50. Cross the railroad tracks, and a bridge. We are at the E end of a curve (after school bus sign). #23407 Hwy 50. By appointment please.
- 3. The Family Orchard** –
The NE corner of Hwy 12 and Hwy 821. Go E from Lacombe on Hwy 12 for 28 km, then N Hwy 821 take 1st driveway on right.
- 4. Golden Willow Ranch**
Go E of Lacombe on Hwy 12 for 13 km to Hwy 815, then S to Twp Rd 390, then E to RR 24-5, then N .8 km. By appointment please.

- 5. Ellis Bird Farm**
Go E of Lacombe on Hwy 12 for 8 km, then S on RR 26-0 (Prentiss Rd) for 8 km. Or, go E of Blackfalds on Hwy 597 for 15 km, then N for 5 km on RR 26-0.
- 6. Billyco Junction**
Go E from Lacombe in Hwy 12 for 8 km, then S on Range Rd 26-0 (Prentiss Rd) for 4.4 km.
- 7. JANTiques**
Go E of Lacombe on Hwy 12 for 8 km, then S on Range Rd 26-0 (Prentiss Rd) for 1.8 km.
- 8. Wolf's Botanical**
Go E of Lacombe on Hwy 12 for 8 km, then S on Range Rd 26-0 (Prentiss Rd) for 1.5 km.

Sunset Farms (West of Highway 2 [QE II])

- 9. The Nursery Golf and Country Club**
Go N of Lacombe 4 km on Hwy 2, NW on RR 27-0 1 km.
- 10. Luymes Apiaries** Go W of Lacombe on Hwy 12 2.4 km, then N on RR 27-3 6.4 km. Turn E on Twp Rd 41-2 1 km. We are on the N side of the road.
- 11. Rieky's Bed and Breakfast/Farm and Country Tours** Go W of Lacombe 8 km on Hwy 12, N on RR 28-0 1 km. We're the 1st house on the E side of road.
- 12. Brown Eggs and Lamb** Go W of Lacombe on Hwy 12 11 km, then S on WoodyNook Road .5 km. We're on the E side of road.
- 13. Summerland Leisure Park**
Go W of Lacombe 12 km on Hwy 12, then S on RR 28-2 for .1 km.

- 14. The Saskatoon Orchard** Go W from Lacombe on Hwy 12 8 km, N on Hwy 792 16 km. W on Twp Rd 422 (Meadowbrook) 3 km, then S RR 283 1.5 km.
- 15. The Fresh Food Farm** Go W from the Blackfalds overpass on Aspelund Rd 12 km, then S on RR 1-1 .8 km. We're on the E side of road.
- 16. T and S Lilies** Go N of Bentley on RR 1-2 (ServusCredit Union corner) 7.2 km. We are at the end of the road.
- 17. Ammonite World** Go W from Bentley on Hwy 12 to Hwy 20, then N for 9 km to Westlake Rd. Go E 1.7 km to RR 15, then S 1 km, on the top of the hill. By appointment please.
- 18. Prairie Pearls** Go W from Bentley to Hwy 20, then S for 6.4 km to Rainy Creek Rd. Go W for 4.8 km, then N on RR 2-0 (at Rainy Creek Recreation and Marine Storage sign). We are the first farm on the left. By appointment please, no Sunday calls.
